

WITNESS

TRANSFIGURATION:

Adapted from Donald Maher A Roman Catholic lay minister in Allentown, Pa

In my ministry, I often highlighted the Transfiguration as Jesus' "coming out" story—coming out as "divine"— revealing his truth for the first time to some of his disciples. Like the three disciples in the Transfiguration stories, our people can often struggle with how to handle such truth.

Jesus worried about the circumstances of revealing his truth: On which disciples and how many of them would first be told; and on where, when and how they would be told.

The disciples hear the news and fall to the ground paralyzed by fear and cannot speak. Jesus acts with compassion and understanding. He goes over to them, crouches down to be with them, touches them, and tells them, "Do not be afraid!"

We know from LGBTQ+ coming-out experiences, that it is not a one time event, for LGBTQ+ people do not come out all at once to everyone and everywhere.

Jesus and his three disciples do not remain on the mountaintop to wallow in the bewilderment of the occasion. Rather, they descend to return to the regular world with knowledge and the experience of his good news and to continue Jesus' public ministry and spread his Gospel message.
